Holy One, now that the day has ended we praise You and ask that this evening and night be safe, peaceful and undisturbed. Grant this, O Savior, and save us.

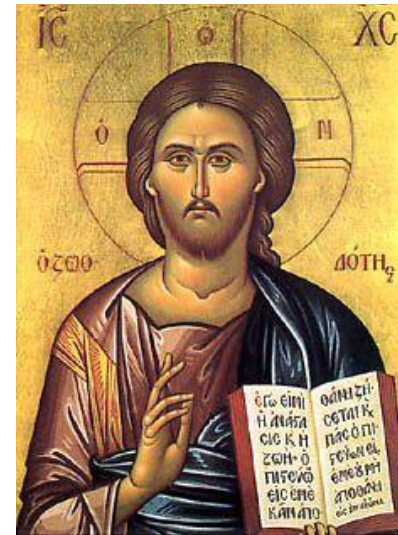
